

CIY // COVID-19 PROTOCOL

Before the Event

- Attendees should purchase and pack hand sanitizer, face coverings (2 masks per day recommended), and wipes.
- Traders Point will provide each leader with an infrared thermometer, hand sanitizer, and disinfectant.

Leader Responsibilities

- Do a temperature check each day and ensure that your group is symptom free.
- Make sure your group is washing their hands, using hand sanitizer, showering, socially distancing, and wearing masks.
- Report to your trip leader immediately if an attendee develops two or more symptoms listed at the end of this document.

Pods

- CIY has requested that we sort all attendees into Pods of no more than 15. For Traders Point, your small group will be your Pod! Pods will be housed together, eat together, sit in main sessions together, and participate in activities together.

Arrivals & Departures

- CIY will stagger the arrival and dismissal of Pods to and from main sessions to avoid large crowds gathering during pre-session times.

Cleaning & Sanitization

- The host campus sanitizes public facilities daily and will clean and sanitize dorms prior to our arrival. Traders Point will provide disinfectant for leaders to clean high-touch surfaces in dorms throughout the week.

Health Screening

- All attendees are asked to limit potential exposure to COVID-19 in the two weeks prior to the event.
- Attendees will be required to complete a survey regarding COVID-related symptoms upon arrival.
- Traders Point Youth Leaders will conduct daily health screenings (including temperature checks) with all of our attendees and report anyone with COVID-related symptoms immediately.

CIY encourages individuals who are eligible to be vaccinated against COVID-19 to consider doing so. Vaccination is **not required to attend.*

Isolation & Testing

- If an individual exhibits two or more symptoms of COVID-19, they'll be isolated and asked to test when appropriate. If a symptomatic individual opts not to be tested, they will be presumed positive.
- If an individual tests positive, they will need to leave campus as soon as possible and we will work with their family to arrange transportation. Traders Point will not *provide* transportation for anyone who tests positive.

- Close contacts of any individual who exhibits symptoms will be quarantined pending test results of the symptomatic individual. If that individual is positive, those close contacts *will be asked to leave the event*. Traders Point will work with families to arrange transportation but will not provide it.
- If the test is negative, the individual will be monitored for 12-24 hours. If symptoms persist, the individual will be asked to leave the event. If symptoms subside the individual will be allowed to rejoin their pod.

**Vaccinated individuals will not be required to isolate or leave the event due to exposure unless they exhibit symptoms.*

Personal Protective Equipment

- Attendees will be expected to wear masks when indoors where six feet of distance from others cannot be maintained. This includes main sessions, small group time, youth group time, meals (except when eating), and any elective sessions.

Social Distancing

- Meal times will be split into multiple shifts to allow additional space between attendees and at least six feet of distance between separate Pods.
- Main sessions will use modified seating arrangements to allow at least six feet of distance between separate Pods.
- Attendees are encouraged to maintain appropriate distances from each other during small group, recreation, and free time.
- Any full youth group gatherings will occur outdoors while maintaining appropriate distancing between Pods.

Contact Tracing

- In the event of a confirmed case of COVID-19, CIY will assist with contact tracing as requested by local health officials to identify those who were in close contact with an individual. In general, only the positive individual's Pod will be considered close contacts unless there is indication that there was extended and/or unmasked close contact with others.
- Close contacts with a confirmed case will need to leave campus, with the exception of those who are fully vaccinated according to CDC guidelines.

Symptoms of Concern

- Fever greater than 100.4 °F
- Headache
- Body Aches
- Chills
- Cough
- Loss of taste and/or smell
- GI distress
- Sore throat
- Congestion
- Fatigue
