Drivers for tear down

Bring trailers back to storage location from the school each week after the tear down process is finished. Experience driving a truck and 24 ft. trailer is necessary, and it's preferred if the drivers are able and willing to use their own personal truck for this.

Setup for Kids & Connections environments

Arrive at church when setup begins and offload all cases from the trailer and take to designated area within the school. Once all cases are in the building, begin setup in assigned area(s). No skill level required beforehand. However, most roles do require pushing large rolling cases and lifting small items out of the cases.

Tear down for Kids & Connections environments

After the final service, go to assigned area and begin tearing down the environments and putting all items into the cases. Once all cases are packed up and pushed to a designated area, begin loading onto the trailer. No skill level required beforehand. However, most roles do require pushing large rolling cases and lifting small items out of the cases.

Set up for Auditorium environments

Arrive at church when setup begins and offload all cases from the trailer and take to the auditorium. Once all cases are inside, begin setup. Some electronic/production skills are preferred to serve in this role, and most positions in the auditorium require heavy lifting.
