Inspire a Love for God and a Love for Others – Members are growing to be more authentic, encouraging and seeking other people in their lives who they can disciple (John 13:34-35, Galatians 5:22-26) and build accountable relationships.

Key Tangibles – Bible study and memorization, spirit-led prayer, worship and life change.

Winning Questions: Are group members engaging with spiritual disciplines? How evident are the fruits of the Spirit in my group members? How open is my group about sin in their life?

CARE

RED

Provide Care – Group members are learning to take initiative and mutually care for one another's needs on a personal level. This means some are being loved and supported while going through hardship or crisis (1 Thessalonians 2:7- 12).

Availability – “People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care.” Your group has a plan for communicating by showing up and extending a hand when life happens.

Winning Questions: Are group members praying for each other? Is there a culture of support within the group? Are you leading with vulnerability as a leader? Are group members' needs being voiced and met?

Reaching the Lost – Group members are developing a heart and compassion for the needy and lost (Mark 16:15).

Winning Questions: Are you generous with your time and money? Are you sharing your faith with others? Are you looking for ways to meet the needs of others and then acting on it?

Addition is Good; Multiplication is Better – Adding members to your group is a very good thing, and we encourage that of all groups. However, your group will run out of space eventually, so multiplying leaders from within groups is essential as TPCC grows.

Winning Questions: Are you delegating leadership responsibilities to potential leaders in your group? Does your group look to include others who are seeking a small group? Are you encouraging group members with leadership potential to step up and lead a small group?

RED – Group isn't practicing this value

YELLOW – Group practices this value, but not consistently

GREEN – Group regularly practices and lives out this value
