NEXT STEPS

START THE LEADING SELF TRACK

Leadership development track sessions are trainings that hit our core leadership content, focusing on what every spiritual leader needs to know, care about, and be able to do.

The Leading Self track will focus on leadership competencies such as time management, self-awareness, the inner health of a leader, and understanding your purpose.

JOIN THE LEADING SELF COHORT

Leading Self cohorts are experiential learning groups made up of 8-10 participants, led by a seasoned leadership coach, that last six months.

While the goal of leadership development tracks is primarily knowledge, the goal of leadership cohorts is to take that knowledge and bring it to the experiential level. The largest component of cohorts is stretch assignments that put the knowledge learned in development tracks into practice. In addition, cohorts provide an environment where participants can process those experiences through peer and facilitated coaching.

You will have an opportunity to apply for a Leading Self cohort upon completion of the Leading Self track.
