

2021 Mission Trips

Participation in this local mission trip experience will provide you with an opportunity to grow your heart for Jesus and the work He's doing across our city. By serving with our partners, you and your team will find out about our partners' "why" and grow in community with one another as you work on projects and social issues together. You'll also learn about ways you can start serving with one of these partners on an ongoing basis for long-term engagement. Our local partnerships will be strengthened, and the kingdom work they're doing will be furthered in the process.

Logistics for the local mission trips:

- **Maximum number per trip:** 12 plus trip leader (Children must be at least 12 years old and accompanied by their parent.)
- **Trip Cost:** \$300 (Cost breakdown at the end of proposal)
- **Dates:** Once per month from March through October – five days, Monday – Friday (approx. 10 - 11 hours per day)
- **Where:**
 - **Monday** – will be all at TPCC Northwest Campus - FAM (our Foster and Adoption Ministry), Life Centers, and Ascent 121 - we will be putting together appreciation gifts that will be delivered during the week to the staff at a different partner each month.
 - **Tuesday** – Brookside Community Development Center/Church
 - **Wednesday** – Str8Up Ministries
 - **Thursday** – Wheeler Mission (Indianapolis)
 - **Friday** – Shepherd Community Center
- **Pre-Trip Meetings:** Three that will include the following...
 - Team building
 - Education – *Toxic Charity*
 - Wheeler 101 Volunteer training
 - Trauma Training (from Back2Back Ministries-Trauma Free World) this has been requested by several of our partners since those they serve have all experienced a lot of trauma.)
- **Post-Trip Meeting:** Debrief and follow-up to check on and help you get engaged in longer term service if you desire to do so.

 - TPCC reusable masks (2)
 - Trauma training
 - Education on our local partnerships
