SERMON STUDY

Read these verses before you begin your discussion: Luke 12:13-21

Dive deeper into this week's message and passage from the Bible. Here are some questions to help you guide your group discussion.

In Luke 12:13-21, the rich man's greed drives him to think enough is never really enough. Can you relate to this? Is "enough" a moving target for you, or are you satisfied and content with what you have?

The quality of your life will be determined by the quality of your relationship with God. How is your relationship with God going right now? Are you growing? Are you stagnant? What is God teaching you?

Life with God starts with death to pride. Have you experienced this? When have you come face-to-face with your pride?

Day one: Luke 12:13-15 | Do you constantly seek more and measure life by what you own?

Day four: Luke 12:6-7 | Do you know that you're truly loved, no matter what you earn or achieve?

Day five: Luke 12:13-21 | Reflect: What do you notice that you didn't notice before? What is God teaching you through his Word? What are you going to do about it?
