TALK ABOUT IT

- 1** **Read Genesis 39:1-6.** What evidence do you see in these verses of the Lord's work in Joseph's life? How do you think you might have reacted to your situation if you were Joseph?
- 2** **Read Genesis 39:7-20.** What stands out to you about the reasoning Joseph gives for denying the advancements of Potiphar's wife?
- 3** What situation do you currently face where it is tempting to not remain faithful to God? How does the example of Joseph give you courage or motivation to remain faithful to God, no matter how tough the situation?
- 4** **Read Genesis 39:21-23.** What theme do you notice playing out in Joseph's life? Where have you seen God's faithfulness evidenced in your own life?
- 5** What is or what has been your 'why' in the past for remaining faithful to God? How can you draw upon His faithfulness to you when tempted to give in?

RESPOND

What is God saying to you through His Word? How and when will you respond?
