## WARM-UP QUESTION

In your opinion, what type of music has the best songs about love? Why?

## **DISCUSS**

- If you could define love in your own words, how would you describe it?
- Where do you see the greatest need for love in our world today?

Read the following passages for three examples of Jesus modeling love. (Options: Assign each passage to a different person to read out loud -or- give everyone a few minutes to read on their own.) After reading each passage, pause to talk through the three questions below.

Mark 10:13-16 Luke 7:11-17 Luke 19:1-10

After each passage, discuss:

- Where do you see love displayed (or not displayed) in this passage?
- What stands out to you in how Jesus responded in this situation?
- What inspires or challenges you in this passage?

## **RESPOND**

- Based on what you've just read and discussed, what do you think God is prompting you to do next? When will you do it?
- Share with your group, and spend a few minutes praying together. Pray that God would give
  each of you a desire to model His love to those around you and that you would take steps
  this week to follow where He leads.
