Use this time to gather together and get everyone talking. Let your kids know that this is safe place for them to share their feelings, emotions and questions.

- For your elementary-aged kids, ask them about the best part of their week. Allow space for them to share a hard part of their week if they would like. For your preschool-aged kids, have them draw something fun from their week.
- **ASK: What is your favorite story or book to read?** Allow your preschoolers to draw a picture if they would like to.

ASK your Elementary Schooler:

- **What did people have to do to be right with God before Jesus?**
- **Why did God need to make a perfect plan? Why did we need to be saved?**
- **If we do not have to follow all the rules the people in the Old Testament did, what does God want us to do now to have a relationship with Him?**

ASK your Preschooler:

- **What did people wave at Jesus when he rode in on a donkey?** (palm branches)
- **What does 'Hosanna' mean?** (Save us)
- **Why was Jesus willing to go to the cross?** (Because He loves us)

have fun together

From playing to praying together, have fun learning more about God!



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- Take some time to pray together as a family. Pray that each person would recognize that Jesus is the best ever. Allow your kids to share any prayer requests that they might have and allow your kids to pray out loud if they would like to.
- Allow your kids to talk through how they want to prepare to celebrate Easter next week. This could be to decorate, bake a treat, invite a friend to church, etc.
