- For your elementary-aged kids, ask them about the best part of their week. Allow space for them to share a hard part of their week if they would like.
- For your preschool-aged kids, have them tell you about and draw something fun from their week.

SAY to your Elementary Schooler:

- **Today we're learning about Pharoah and the plagues in Egypt.**
 - **The Israelites were afraid during the plagues. Let's read about what God tells them to do in Joshua 1:9.**
- **What does this verse encourage us to do?** (be strong, don't be afraid, don't lose hope)
- **What does this verse say about God?** (He is our God, He will never leave us)

SAY to your Preschooler:

- Let's roll a ball back and forth to each other while we review what we learned today.
 - **ASK: When the people were hungry, did God give them boots for their feet or food to eat?** (Food to eat)
 - **ASK: When the people were thirsty, did God give His people a mountain to climb or water to drink?** (Water to drink)
 - **ASK: When Moses and God's people needed help, they asked God to help them. And what did God do — did He gallop away or help them?** (He helped them)
