WATCH TODAY'S MESSAGE

Keep the conversation going while doing the activities listed below.*

Materials Needed: Bible, blank paper, coloring utensils

DO

Today we learned that one of the names for God is Healer. When we spend time getting to know more about God, we can trust and follow Him every day.

As a family, read Psalm 9:10 from a Bible or Bible app.

PLAY

Read the following questions, and have your child draw the corresponding objects:

- If you fall and scrape your knee, do you put a hat or Band-aid on it? (Draw a band-aid)
- Have you ever had your temperature taken with a thermometer? (Draw a thermometer)
- Do you remember getting a shot at the doctor's office? (Draw the body part where you got a shot)
- Who takes care of you when you are feeling sick? (Draw a heart to represent God and family)
- When your sins separate you from God, can Jesus make you close again? (Draw a cross)

PRAY

Dear God, thank You for being our Healer. Thank you for healing our biggest hurt of all-being separate from you because of our sins. Thank you for sending Jesus! We love You! In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
